

GEOGRAPHY ENTRY LEVEL



This syllabus provides a framework for a course which will meet the needs of students whose abilities at the start of the year appear to be below the standard required to gain a GCSE in Geography. The course is intended to be taught and learned in an active way, with opportunities still being made available for residential fieldwork.

Topics studied include: Rivers
Settlement
Volcanoes
Earthquakes
Tourism (National Parks)

Pupils are assessed continuously throughout the two year course and no exams are undertaken.
