

MODERN LANGUAGES

FRENCH and ITALIAN GCSEs

These are two year courses open to all pupils who have studied the language in main stream at KS3 and who wish to further their language skills of listening, speaking, reading and writing. There are two levels of entry: foundation and higher, catering for all abilities.

Topics include Holidays, Leisure, Family, Town, Environment, School Future Plans, the World of Work, Sport and Cinema.

Conversation classes take place with the Language Assistants and there is an opportunity of utilising the Modern Languages IT suite. Pupils also benefit from a GCSE revision course in Cardiff and workshops at Cardiff University. A study trip to France and Italy is offered.
