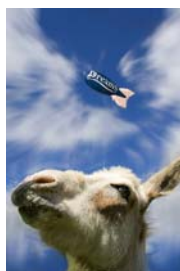


PHOTOGRAPHY GCSE

The course in Year 10 introduces students to all aspects of Photography, including the practical use of the camera, processing and printing techniques. Practical work will involve documentary photography, personal enquiry and individual expression.

Traditional and digital photography is taught and pupils will work towards the award of GCSE Art-Photography. Pupils will examine the social and cultural purposes to which photography has been put, and the meanings of photographic images. Two units of work will be produced over two years and an end of Year examination is set which is worth 40% of the total GCSE mark. The coursework is worth 60% of the total GCSE mark.



The course can lead to an Advanced Level in Photography available in the Barry 6th Form.
